Title III Wagner-Peyser Employment Services

The One Stop delivery system provides universal access to an integrated array of labor exchange services so that workers, job seekers and businesses can find the services they need in one stop and frequently under one roof in easy-to-find locations.

The Employment Service focuses on providing a variety of employment related labor exchange services including but not limited to job search assistance, job referral, and placement assistance for job seekers, re-employment services to unemployment insurance claimants, and recruitment services to employers with job openings. Services are delivered in one of three modes including self-service, facilitated self-help services and staff assisted service delivery approaches.

 Examples: Job referrals to jobs and resources, job placement, career enhancement, LMI etc.

Agricultural Recruitment System

H2A job orders are sent by our Foreign Labor Certification (FLC) unit to recruit Agricultural workers by providing them openings in Arizona. Employment Services (ES) staff, will provide referrals to anyone looking to work in the Agricultural filed.

- Receive New H2A job orders to promote for those seeking agricultural work
- Is disseminated to office staff so that they may try to refer local domestic workers interested in the position for employment
